What makes a livable city? How is sustainable development possible? A comparison of leading cities like Strasbourg shows that public transportation and public spaces require urban development, and we need civic participation opportunities to improve the city environment and make it more humane.

In this presentation, we focus on the challenge of sustainable development in a local city, Okayama, which has featured in a UNESCO Education for Sustainable Development (ESD). This presentation focuses on the following.

We examine the current state under regional revitalization policy and give examples of citizen participation in Nishigawa Canal Park, while also addressing how new partnerships can be made among the citizen, the local administration, and higher education.
